R.B. No. 2 AA Supporting Veteran-Owned Small Businesses**

Good afternoon Senator Flexer, Representative Hennessy, Senator Martin, Representative Yaccarino, and Members of the Veterans' Affairs Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to submit this written testimony in support of Raised Bill No. 2 An Act Supporting Veteran-Owned Small Businesses.
