At 2:25 p.m.; Sandra Fae Brown-Brewton moved, seconded by Robert Coffey that regarding Armando Bettini; the Subcommittee recommend to the Retirement Commission that it deny his request to accept his late application to purchase his prior military service for retirement credit purposes. Majority vote in favor 2-1. Carl Chisem dissenting

At 2:35 p.m.; Sandra Fae Brown-Brewton moved, seconded by Robert Coffey that regarding Edward Buchweitz; the Subcommittee recommend to the Retirement Commission that it deny his request to rescind his retirement plan membership in ARP for the purposes of having membership in the SERS Tier IV retirement plan. All voted in favor.

At 2:50 p.m.; Sandra Fae Brown-Brewton moved, seconded by Robert Coffey that regarding Tina Williams-Knight; the Subcommittee recommend to the Retirement Commission that it deny her request that the Commission review and reconsider its July 19, 2018 decision to bring her May 1, 2009 application for non-service connected disability retirement to closure. All voted in favor.

At 2:55 p.m.; Sandra Fae Brown-Brewton moved, seconded by Robert Coffey that regarding Lauren Tucker; the Subcommittee recommend to the Retirement Commission that it deny her request to divest her membership in SERS Tier III for the purposes of enrolling in the Teachers Retirement System (TRS). All voted in favor.
