1 (Proceedings commenced at 9:07 a.m.)

2 DR. LIEDERS: So, the meeting comes to  
3 order. My name is Dr. Lieders. The March 19, 2021  
4 meeting of the Medical Examining Board is now in  
5 session.

6 By the way, I should also mention  
7 that the meeting is conducted via Zoom, with video  
8 and audio.

9 Present are members of the Medical  
10 Examining Board, myself, Dr. Blum and Dr. Rosenberg.  
11 Present from the Office of the State Comptroller  
12 Retirement Services Division are staff members from  
13 the Retirement services Division Annette Sadlowski,  
14 Robert Helfand, William Cassada, as well as general  
15 counsel for the Retirement Commission Cindy Cieslak.

16 There's a motion to amend the agenda.  
17 I didn't even know that we had Jeffrey Luciano on  
18 the agenda; but, apparently, we need to remove his  
19 name. So, I'm making a motion to re remove  
20 Jeffrey Luciano from the agenda.

21 DR. BLUM: Second.

22 DR. LIEDERS: Is there any discussion?

23 No discussion. All in favor say aye.

24 All opposed say nay. Motion passes. So, we now  
25 have an amended agenda.

1                   Just let me explain. We're going --  
2 it's a public session; so, members of the  
3 executive -- members of the Medical Examining Board  
4 will be meeting in executive session to discuss the  
5 individual applicants.

6                   While we are in executive session,  
7 the meeting is going to be closed to the public.

8                   So, I'm going to make a motion for us  
9 to go into executive session. Is there any second?

10                  DR. BLUM: Second.

11                  DR. LIEDERS: Is there any discussion?  
12 All in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The  
13 motion passes. We're in executive session, and I'm  
14 going to ask that members of -- staff members of the  
15 Retirement Services Division as well as general  
16 counsel for the Retirement Commission,  
17 Ms. Cindy Cieslak, to remain to attend the meeting  
18 as well.

19                  MS. CIELAK: Thank you, Dr. Lieders. I  
20 just want to say, Mr. Peterson, what that means is  
21 I'm going to put you back in the waiting room until  
22 the doctors are ready to discuss your case. Okay?

23                  MR. PETERSON: Okay.

24                  MS. CIELAK: All right. Thank you.

25

1 (The Board was in executive session  
2 from 9:09 a.m. until 1:31 p.m.)

3 MS. CIELAK: All right. Dr. Lieders, I  
4 believe everyone is back from the waiting room, and  
5 we are out of executive session so you may proceed.

6 DR. LIEDERS: Okay. Welcome everybody.  
7 The Board will be making determinations and voting  
8 on those determinations; but, I would like to remind  
9 members that only the final vote will be given today  
10 and not the reasons for the vote.

11 In some instances there may not have  
12 been enough medical information to make a  
13 determination, or perhaps a non-service-connected  
14 disability is more likely than a service-connected  
15 disability. You may seek reconsideration of an  
16 initial denial. You will receive the Board's  
17 written determination within two to four weeks,  
18 which will then provide you with additional  
19 information.

20 So, I'm going to proceed and I'm  
21 going to make a motion to approve Pierre D'Haiti's  
22 application for service-connected disability  
23 retirement.

24 DR. BLUM: Second.

25 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?

1 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
2 say nay. The motion passes.

3 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to deny  
4 Dawn Dube's application for service-connected  
5 disability retirement; however the Board will look  
6 favorably upon a non-service-connected retirement.

7 MS. CIELAK: Is there a second?

8 DR. BLUM: Second.

9 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?

10 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
11 say nay. The motion passes.

12 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to table  
13 Valerie Fazzino's application for  
14 non-service-connected disability retirement.

15 MS. HOXIE: I'm sorry. What does that  
16 mean? This is Katherine Hoxie.

17 DR. BLUM: She's still on?

18 MS. CIELAK: Ms. Hoxie, the doctors are  
19 voting on all of the decisions. They will either  
20 approve, deny or table, and so they're going through  
21 the agenda right now.

22 MS. HOXIE: Oh, I'm sorry. I am so sorry.

23 MS. CIELAK: That's okay.

24 All right. I believe, Dr. Lieders,  
25 you have moved to table Ms. Fazzino's application

1 for non-service-connected disability. I don't think  
2 I heard a second.

3 DR. BLUM: Second.

4 How did she get on the line?

5 MS. CIELAK: Hi, Dr. Blum. We are in  
6 public session, so anyone who is still in the  
7 waiting room has been admitted --

8 DR. BLUM: I see.

9 MS. CIELAK: -- since it is an open,  
10 public meeting.

11 Annette, do you have a second for  
12 Ms. Fazzino?

13 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

14 MS. SADLOWSKI: Yes, Dr. Rosenberg.

15 MS. CIELAK: Okay. It's been seconded.

16 Any further discussion? There being  
17 none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed say nay.  
18 The motion passes.

19 DR. ROSENBERG: Dr. Lieders, I believe you  
20 missed the very first person on the list when you  
21 were going down the list.

22 DR. LIEDERS: Pierre D'Haiti?

23 DR. ROSENBERG: Yes.

24 DR. LIEDERS: No. We did him.

25 DR. ROSENBERG: Then I missed it and I

1 apologize. Sorry.

2 MS. CIELAK: Annette Sadlowski, do you  
3 have a record of the vote on Mr. Pierre D'Haiti?

4 MS. SADLOWSKI: Yes, I do.

5 MS. CIELAK: Okay, Dr. Lieders, go ahead.

6 DR. LIEDERS: Can we move on?

7 DR. ROSENBERG: Yes.

8 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
9 approve Cheryl Ferris's application for  
10 non-service-connected disability retirement.

11 DR. BLUM: Second.

12 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
13 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
14 say nay. The motion passes.

15 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
16 approve Kelly Fisher's application for  
17 service-connected disability retirement.

18 DR. BLUM: Second.

19 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
20 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
21 say nay. The motion passes.

22 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
23 approve Katherine Hoxie's application for  
24 non-service-connected disability retirement.

25 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

1 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
2 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
3 say nay. The motion passes.

4 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
5 approve Karen Johnson's application for  
6 service-connected disability retirement.

7 DR. BLUM: Second.

8 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
9 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
10 say nay. The motion passes, two to one.

11 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
12 approve Brad Knorr's application for  
13 non-service-connected retirement?

14 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

15 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
16 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
17 say nay. The motion passes.

18 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to deny  
19 Joshua Malaro's application for service-connected  
20 disability retirement; however, the Board will look  
21 favorably on a non-service-connected retirement.

22 DR. BLUM: Second.

23 MS. CIELAK: Any discussion? There being  
24 none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed say nay.  
25 The motion passes.



1 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to deny  
2 Timothy O'Neill's application for service-connected  
3 disability retirement; however, the Board will look  
4 favorably upon a non-service-connected disability  
5 retirement.

6 DR. BLUM: Second.

7 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
8 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
9 say nay. The motion passes.

10 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
11 approve Wanda Orengo's application for  
12 service-connected disability retirement.

13 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

14 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
15 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
16 say nay. The motion passes.

17 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
18 approve Brian Peterson's application for  
19 non-service-connected disability retirement.

20 DR. BLUM: Second.

21 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
22 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
23 say nay. The motion passes.

24 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
25 approve Jean Richards' application for

1 non-service-connected disability retirement.

2 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

3 MS. CIELAK: I'm just going to make sure.

4 I believe the application was for both non-service

5 or service, and this is for non-service?

6 DR. LIEDERS: I'm sorry. We changed it.

7 It was for non-service and service.

8 DR. BLUM: It's non-service.

9 DR. LIEDERS: So I'm going to rephrase it.

10 DR. BLUM: It's approved for non-service.

11 DR. LIEDERS: No, no, no. I'm going to  
12 rephrase it.

13 MS. CIELAK: Dr. Lieders, there is a  
14 motion on the floor for non-service. In the  
15 event --

16 DR. LIEDERS: I see.

17 DR. ROSENBERG: I will withdraw that.

18 MS. CIELAK: So Dr. Rosenberg has  
19 withdrawn the second. Wait. Who seconded the  
20 motion?

21 DR. ROSENBERG: I did.

22 MS. CIELAK: Okay. Dr. Rosenerg has  
23 withdrawn the second. Dr. Lieders, you also need to  
24 withdraw your motion.

25 DR. LIEDERS: I'll withdraw my motion.

1 It's a little confusing when they apply for both  
2 service and non-service at the same time.

3 So I'm going to rephrase. I'm going  
4 to do another motion.

5 I'm going to make a motion to approve  
6 Jean Richards' application for service-connected  
7 disability retirement.

8 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

9 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
10 There being none all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
11 say nay. The motion passes.

12 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
13 approve Kimberly Robinson-Carr's application for  
14 service-connected disability retirement.

15 DR. BLUM: Second.

16 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
17 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
18 say nay. The motion passes.

19 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
20 approve John Stephenson's application for  
21 non-service-connected disability retirement.

22 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

23 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
24 There being none, nay all in favor say aye. Any  
25 opposed say nay. The motion passes.

1 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to  
2 approve Richard Stern's application for  
3 service-connected disability retirement.

4 DR. ROSENBERG: Second.

5 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
6 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
7 say nay. The motion passes.

8 DR. LIEDERS: I'll make a motion to table  
9 Sydney Yelton's application for service-connected  
10 disability retirement.

11 DR. BLUM: Second.

12 MS. CIELAK: Any further discussion?  
13 There being none, all in favor say aye. Any opposed  
14 ed say nay. The motion passes.

15 Dr. Lieders, before you make a motion  
16 to adjourn, can you provide me the decision on  
17 Ms. Ferris?

18 DR. LIEDERS: I'm sorry. On whom?

19 MS. CIELAK: Ms. Cheryl Ferris.

20 DR. LIEDERS: Approved.

21 MS. CIELAK: For non-service or service?

22 DR. LIEDERS: It was approved for  
23 non-service, I believe.

24 MS. CIELAK: Okay. I just wanted to make  
25 sure my notes were accurate.

1 DR. LIEDERS: So, I'll make a motion to  
2 adjourn today's meeting.

3 DR. BLUM: Second.

4 DR. LIEDERS: Is there any discussion?  
5 All in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The  
6 motion passes. Meeting adjourned. Thank you,  
7 ladies and gentlemen. nice weekend.
