1 (Meeting commenced at 9:01 a.m.)

2 DR. GALVIN: The August 21, 2020 meeting  
3 of the Medical Examining Board is now in session.  
4 I'm Dr. Robert Galvin. I am the chairperson for  
5 this meeting. I will be ably assisted by  
6 Dr. Richard Blum and Dr. Marianne Wudarsky. Present  
7 from the office of the State Comptroller Retirement  
8 Services Division are Annette Sadlowski and  
9 Colin Newman, and in observance -- an observer of  
10 the Medical Examining Board meeting, a new member,  
11 Dr. Ralph Rosenberg, and also general counsel for  
12 the Retirement Commission, cindy Cieslak.

13 There no motions to amend the agenda,  
14 so I will now suggest -- make a motion for the Board  
15 to go into executive session. I need a second on  
16 that.

17 DR. BLUM: Second.

18 DR. GALVIN: I request that the members of  
19 the Retirement Service Division and counsel be  
20 allowed to remain.

21 MS. CIESLAK: Is there any further  
22 discussion on the motion? All in favor say aye.  
23 Any opposed say nay. The motion passes.

24 (The Commission was in executive session  
25 from 9:02 a.m. until 11:47 a.m.)

1 MS. CIESLAK: I want to remind you all  
2 that I've turned the recording back on and we are in  
3 public session, so when you are speaking, please  
4 announce who is speaking.

5 DR. GALVIN: Okay. I'll read this  
6 statement again.

7 The Board will be making  
8 determinations and voting on those determinations.  
9 I would like to remind the members that only the  
10 final vote will be given today and not the reasons  
11 for the vote. In some instances, there may not have  
12 been enough medical information to make a  
13 determination, or perhaps a non-service-connected  
14 disability is more likely a service-connected  
15 disability. You may seek reconsideration of initial  
16 denial. You will receive the Board's written  
17 determination within two to four weeks, which will  
18 provide you with additional information.

19 Okay. Now I'm going to start to go  
20 through the list. Annette, there's nothing  
21 additional we have to do for approving Social  
22 Security people?

23 MS. SADLOWSKI: No. Yes, that's only on  
24 the 24-month reviews, so there's nothing further.

25 DR. GALVIN: Okay. We're going to vote.

1 Rhonda Boyd. I move to deny the  
2 service-connected application of Rhonda Boyd. Do I  
3 have a second?

4 DR. BLUM: Second.

5 DR. GALVIN: All in favor?

6 DR. BLUM: That's usually Cindy's job.

7 DR. GALVIN: Okay. Then I'll let Cindy do  
8 it. Sorry. I got carried away with the authority.

9 MS. CIESLAK: Dr. Galvin, the chairperson  
10 can certainly call the notes. In the Retirement  
11 Commission meetings, the chairperson calls the  
12 votes. I have assisted in the past only to, you  
13 know, help everyone with the process. So,  
14 Dr. Galvin, if you would like to do it, feel free.

15 DR. GALVIN: Nope. It sounds better when  
16 you do it. It sounds more professional when you do  
17 it.

18 So Boyd is denied.

19 MS. CIESLAK: Yes. You called the vote,  
20 it was unanimous, three to zero.

21 DR. GALVIN: Okay. Go ahead. Next is  
22 Lisa Carter.

23 MS. CIESLAK: Would someone like to make  
24 the motion?

25 DR. GALVIN: I move that we deny the

1 service-connected application for disability for  
2 Lisa Carter; however, the Board would positively  
3 regard an application for non-service disability.

4 DR. BLUM: Second.

5 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion? All  
6 in favor say aye. Any posed say nay. The motion  
7 passes.

8 DR. GALVIN: Sounds much better when you  
9 do it, Cindy.

10 MS. CIESLAK: Thank you.

11 DR. GALVIN: You're welcome.

12 Jessica Chadbourne, Dr. W?

13 DR. WUDARSKY: To approve for disability  
14 which is service connected.

15 DR. GALVIN: Okay. You moved to approve  
16 service-connected disability for Jessica Chadbourne.  
17 I will second that.

18 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion?

19 DR. BLUM: Bob, you're supposed to say  
20 this thing, right?

21 MS. CIESLAK: This is Cindy. Any doctor  
22 can make a motion. It doesn't have to be --

23 DR. BLUM: Any doctor? Oh, okay.

24 MS. CIESLAK: I think Dr. Galvin had  
25 suggested that the doctor who had presented the case

1 could make the motion.

2 Again, any of the doctors can make  
3 motions, any of the doctors can second. So we --

4 Is there any further discussion on  
5 the motion to approve Jessica Chadbourne? Hearing  
6 none, all in favor say aye. All opposed say nay.  
7 The motion passes.

8 DR. GALVIN: Stephanie Edwards.  
9 Dr. Wudarsky?

10 DR. WUDARSKY: I make a determination of a  
11 non-service-connected disability approval.

12 DR. BLUM: Second.

13 DR. GALVIN: Okay. I second that.

14 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion? All  
15 in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion  
16 passes.

17 DR. BLUM: I make a motion to approve the  
18 service-connected disability of Iris Fuqua.

19 DR. GALVIN: Second.

20 MS. CIESLAK: Dr. Blum made the motion,  
21 Dr. Galvin seconded. Is there any further  
22 discussion? All in favor say aye. All opposed say  
23 nay. The motion passes.

24 If we are going in alphabetical  
25 order, we have to have a motion for Brendan Firetto.

1 DR. GALVIN: I'll make a motion to approve  
2 the non-service disability of Brendan Firetto.

3 DR. BLUM: Second.

4 MS. CIESLAK: Any discussion? All in  
5 favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion  
6 passes.

7 DR. GALVIN: Want to do Mr. Jenkins,  
8 Dr. Blum?

9 DR. BLUM: Jenkins?

10 DR. GALVIN: Yes.

11 DR. BLUM: Jenkins was assigned to me but  
12 I never had it on my list. Why don't you --

13 DR. GALVIN: Oh, wait a minute.

14 DR. BLUM: You're going to do it, I guess.

15 DR. GALVIN: Yes, I'm going to write it  
16 up. I'm sorry. I forgot that. I'm sorry.

17 I move we approve the application for  
18 non-service disability of Rick Jenkins.

19 DR. BLUM: Approve.

20 MS. CIESLAK: Dr. Blum, was that a second?  
21 Dr. Blum, did you second the motion?

22 DR. BLUM: Yes.

23 MS. CIESLAK: Okay. Thank you.

24 So we have a motion to approve  
25 non-service made by Dr. Galvin for Rick Jenkins.

1 Dr. Blum has seconded. Any further discussion? All  
2 in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion  
3 passes.

4 DR. GALVIN: Next is Megan Khairallah,  
5 Dr. Wudarsky?

6 DR. WUDARSKY: I make the motion to  
7 approve the non-service-connected disability  
8 retirement for Megan Khairallah.

9 DR. GALVIN: Second.

10 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion? All  
11 in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion  
12 passes.

13 DR. GALVIN: Ken Kiely, I guess is how you  
14 pronounce the name. I make a motion to approve the  
15 service-connected disability application of  
16 Kenneth Kiely.

17 DR. BLUM: Second.

18 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion? All  
19 in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion  
20 passes.

21 DR. GALVIN: I presented Douglas Latham,  
22 and I'll make a motion to approve the  
23 service-connected disability of Douglas Latham.

24 DR. BLUM: Second.

25 MS. CIESLAK: For the record, Dr. Galvin



1 made the motion. Dr. Blum seconded the motion. Is  
2 there any discussion? All in favor say aye. All  
3 opposed say nay. The motion passes.

4 DR. GALVIN: Ann Locicero. I make a  
5 motion to disapprove the non-service application of  
6 Ann Locicero.

7 DR. BLUM: Second.

8 MS. CIESLAK: Dr. Galvin has made the  
9 motion to disapprove, or otherwise deny, the  
10 application. It's been seconded by Dr. Blum. Is  
11 there any further discussion? All in favor say aye.  
12 All opposed say nay. The motion passes.

13 Dr. Galvin, before you move on to the  
14 next one, I just want to make sure the record is  
15 clear. You did say "disapprove" of Ann Locicero,  
16 correct?

17 DR. GALVIN: Yes. There's a lot of - she  
18 was the one with all the mixed information in there.

19 MS. CIESLAK: Okay. Thank you.

20 DR. BLUM: I make a motion to approve the  
21 service-connected disability of Daniel Lynch.

22 DR. GALVIN: Second.

23 MS. CIESLAK: Motion was made by Dr. Blum.  
24 Dr. Galvin seconded the motion. Any further  
25 discussion? All in favor say aye. All opposed say

1     nay.   The motion passes.

2             DR. WUDARSKY:   For Brent Michaud, I make a  
3     motion to approve of his application for  
4     service-connected disability retirement.   Do I have  
5     a second?

6             DR. GALVIN:    Second.

7             DR. BLUM:     Yes, second.

8             MS. CIESLAK:   Is there any further  
9     discussion?   All in favor say aye.   All opposed say  
10    nay.   The motion passes.

11            DR. WUDARSKY:   For Marisol Morales, I  
12    motion to approve her application for  
13    non-service-connected disability retirement.   Do I  
14    have a second?

15            DR. GALVIN:    Second.

16            DR. BLUM:     Second.

17            MS. CIESLAK:   Any further discussion?   For  
18    the record, Dr. Wudarsky made the motion, Dr. Galvin  
19    and Dr. Blum both indicated a second.   All in favor  
20    say aye.   All opposed say nay.   The motion passes.

21            DR. BLUM:     I make a motion to approve the  
22    service-connected reconsideration of  
23    Sherene Nelson.

24            DR. GALVIN:    Galvin seconds.

25            MS. CIESLAK:   Thank you, Dr. Blum, for

1 your motion. Thank you, Dr. Galvin, for your  
2 second. Any further discussion? All in favor say  
3 aye. All opposed say nay. The motion passes.

4 DR. GALVIN: I think Nelson is next.

5 MS. CIESLAK: The motion was just on  
6 Nelson, so I think Louis Perez is next.

7 DR. BLUM: I'm sorry. Louis Perez. I  
8 make a motion to approve the service-connected  
9 disability of Louis Perez.

10 DR. GALVIN: Galvin seconds.

11 MS. CIESLAK: Thank you, Dr. Blum, for  
12 your motion. Thank you, Dr. Galvin, for your  
13 second. Is there any discussion? All in favor say  
14 aye. All opposed say nay. The motion passes.

15 DR. GALVIN: Roy Perry. I make a motion  
16 to approve the non-service disability application of  
17 Roy Perry.

18 MS. CIESLAK: Wudarsky seconds. Is there  
19 any discussion? For the record, Dr. Galvin made the  
20 motion.

21 Any further discussion? All in favor  
22 say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion passes.

23 DR. GALVIN: Anibal Quinones. Dr. Galvin  
24 makes a motion to approve the service-connected  
25 disability of Mr. Anibal Quinones.

1 DR. BLUM: Blum.

2 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion? All  
3 in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion  
4 passes.

5 DR. BLUM: I make a motion to approve the  
6 service-connected disability of Scott Sexton. Do I  
7 hear a second?

8 DR. GALVIN: Second.

9 MS. CIESLAK: Thank you, Dr. Blum, for  
10 your motion. Thank you, Dr. Galvin, for your  
11 second. Any further discussion? All in favor say  
12 aye. All opposed say nay. The motion passes.

13 DR. GALVIN: I make a motion to deny the  
14 service-connected request for disability of  
15 Michael Vogt; however, it will be noted that the  
16 Board will favorably consider an application for  
17 non-service-connected disability. Do I have a  
18 second?

19 DR. WUDARSKY: Second.

20 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion? All  
21 in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. The motion  
22 passes.

23 DR. WUDARSKY: Motion to deny the  
24 service-connected disability of Autumn Waggoner. Do  
25 I have a second?

1 DR. GALVIN: Galvin seconds.

2 MS. CIESLAK: Any further discussion? All  
3 in favor say aye.

4 DR. WUDARSKY: Further discussion?

5 Dr. Wudarsky will be asking the --

6 MS. CIESLAK: Dr. Wudarsky, real quick  
7 just for -- I want to make sure that you're not  
8 going to disclose any sort of medical condition in  
9 public session, to protect the applicant.

10 DR. WUDARSKY: Okay.

11 MS. CIESLAK: The information that you  
12 would like to seek from the applicant you can  
13 provide in the written writeup that the applicant  
14 will receive.

15 DR. WUDARSKY: Okay. Got it. No more  
16 discussion.

17 MS. CIESLAK: Anyone else have any further  
18 discussion? All in favor say aye. All opposed say  
19 nay. The motion passes.

20 I believe that concludes the  
21 business.

22 DR. GALVIN: I'll be writing up the  
23 reports so you can get them to me.

24 DR. WUDARSKY: Yes. When do you need  
25 them?

1 DR. GALVIN: Last night. Whenever you can  
2 get them done.

3 DR. WUDARSKY: All right.

4 DR. BLUM: What is your email?

5 MS. CIESLAK: Hold on real quick.

6 Dr. Galvin, we are still recording. We are still in  
7 an open meeting. I would recommend that you don't  
8 provide your email address on an open meeting, for  
9 the privacy of the doctors on the Board here. This  
10 is cindy Cieslak, for the record.

11 DR. GALVIN: Okay.

12 MS. CIESLAK: Any further matters to be  
13 discussed, you can discuss them, or you can adjourn  
14 your meeting.

15 DR. GALVIN: Okay. I make a motion to  
16 adjourn this meeting of the Medical Examining Board.

17 DR. BLUM: Second.

18 DR. WUDARSKY: Second.

19 MS. CIESLAK: So Dr. Galvin made a motion  
20 to adjourn. It was seconded. Any discussion? All  
21 in favor say aye. All opposed say nay. We are  
22 adjourned. Thank you.
