CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay, thank you. Thank you, Cindy. We'll move on to the Chairman's Report. I will defer to John Herrington. Is John here? Yeah, there he is.

MR. HERRINGTON: Yep. So I sent around just now our report for this month. We continue to have low volumes of retirements. I think, you know, everyone that wanted to retire in this window, retired in 2022. We continue to use the excess capacity to work on other projects and, you know, eliminate backlogs where possible.

I would say probably the most time that we've spent on a particular project over the past probably six weeks or so, all of our work is kind of related to potential reforms to the MERS plan. This is something that we'll discuss more in depth later on in the meeting, but we are working through some potential legislative changes with the goal of decreasing the increase in the employer rates, and we'll talk about that in much detail later.

Another thing to report would be that the

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state auditors just issued their most recent report for
their most recent audit, and the most significant
finding that they raised is a finding that they raised
a number of times in the past relating to our
application of the 60-percent minimum and our adherence
to the existing collective of our (inaudible) unit.
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There continues to be a request that we seek an attorney general's opinion on that matter. This commission has sought opinions from its existing counsel. I don't know where that would go, but I will forward that report to all the commission members later today.

But that's all I have to report today.
