LUCIANO: This is a recommendation for 9 the full committee; correct? For the Retirement 10 11 Division next week; right? Because we - as a subcommittee, we don't have the authority to do this. 12 MR. CAREY: Correct, but if we're - but our 13 recommendation is for, ultimately if it were 14 15 implemented, the division would have to do something. So the division would be sending the member a letter-16 MR. LUCIANO: And maybe not telling him what 17 to do, but to say that legislation would be required in 18 order for us to pay him back. Is that-19 MR. CAREY: That's perfect. Perfect. 20 21 MR. O'BRIEN: That makes more sense, yeah. 22 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. 23 MR.
