1 (Proceedings commenced at 8:34 a.m.) 2 3 4 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay, Peter Adomeit 5 speaking. This is the April the 12th meeting of the 6 7 State Employees Retirement Commission Legal & Personnel Subcommittee being held remotely using Zoom technology. 8 9 Do we have the attendance, Cindy? MS. CIESLAK: Yes. Good morning. This is 10 11 Cindy Cieslak. Present this morning, we have Chairman Peter Adomeit; Trustee Michael Carey; Trustee Michael 12 O'Brien; Division Director John Herrington; Assistant 13 Director from the Retirement Services Division, Robert 14 15 Helfand; Yam Menon, General Counsel and Assistant Comptroller; Michael Rose and Cindy Cieslak from Rose 16 Kallor, General Counsel to the Retirement Commission; 17 Bruce Barth and Elizabeth Gupta from Robinson & Cole, 18 19 Tax Counsel to the Retirement Division. Thank you. 20 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Thank you. We need a motion to approve the agenda. 21 22 MR. CAREY: This is Mike Carey. So moved. 23 MR. O'BRIEN: Second, Michael O'Brien. CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: All in favor, say aye or 24 raise your hand. It's unanimous; the ayes have it. 25

1 New business, CMERS SPD. Who is doing the 2 heavy lifting on this one? 3 MR. BARTH: John, I believe. 4 MR. HERRINGTON: Oh, okay, all right. I thought I was off, leaving that to you, Bruce. But 5 yeah, so we're in the process of updating our website 6 7 across the board, and one of the first steps to that is to ensure that we have updated SPDs for all of the 8 plans. Last month, we sent the non-hybrid SPDs for all 9 of the SERS plans. This month, we have the MERS SPD. 10 11 The MERS SPD, I think, is complete. There were a couple of edits that Bruce circulated. 12 We're fine with those, and we can circulate that to the group 13 in advance of presentation to the full commission next 14 15 week, I would say. Unless there's anything that stood out to you, Bruce? 16 MR. BARTH: No, just that one issue I raised, 17 which is a small one. So-18 19 MR. HERRINGTON: Right, and that one, we'll 20 get back to you, but that issue is resolved on the form, the form that people fill out-21 22 MR. BARTH: Okay. 23 MR. HERRINGTON: -- to complete the survivor option. That's where the distinction in terms of where 24 the money goes in the case of a decedent - or a 25

deceased contingent annuitant for the 10- to 20-year 1 2 option. 3 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. Do you want to put 4 that on the agenda for the next meeting of the commission? 5 MR. HERRINGTON: Okay. 6 7 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Yeah, we'll have to get well, the packet hasn't gone out yet. 8 9 MR. HERRINGTON: Okay. CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay, executive session, 10 11 we need a motion to go into executive session, please. MR. CAREY: Mr. Chairman, this is Mike Carey. 12 I move that we go into executive session to discuss 13 Items 1 through 9 on the executive session agenda and 14 15 that we invite into the session Cindy Cieslak, Bruce Barth, Liz Gupta, Mike Rose, and John Herrington, and 16 Bert Helfand. 17 Did I get everybody? 18 19 MR. BARTH: Yam. MR. CAREY: Do we have to include Yam in the 20 invite? And Yam Menon as well. Thanks, Bruce. 21 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Yeah. 22 23 MR. O'BRIEN: Michael O'Brien, second. CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: All in favor, say aye or 24 25 raise your hand.

3	have it.

16	Okay. We now need a motion on Weinstein.
17	MR. CAREY: Mr. Chairman, this is Mike Carey.
18	In the Weinstein matter, I move that we recommend to
19	the full commission that given - or based on the
20	limited - or limited to the specific facts of this case
21	and given the record of communication in this matter,
22	and without setting any precedent for any future matter
23	before the commission, that we recommend the commission
24	grant Ms. Weinstein's request.
25	MS. WEINSTEIN: Yes.

1	MR. O'BRIEN: Mike O'Brien, second.
2	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Any discussion? Hearing
3	none, all in favor, say aye or raise your hand.
4	MR. CAREY: Aye.
5	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Opposed, nay or raise your
6	hand. The ayes have it.
7	Well, we made it.
8	MR. CAREY: We did indeed. So then, Mr.
9	Chairman, this is Mike Carey. I move that we adjourn.
10	MR. O'BRIEN: Mike O'Brien, second.
11	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Any discussion? Hearing
12	none, all in favor, say aye or raise your hand. It's
13	unanimous. Thank you all very much.
14	MR. CAREY: Thanks, all. Take care.
