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CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: And, Mr. Hill, would you please raise your hand? MR. KRAYESKI: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. David Krayeski. I wanted to welcome Brian. When we had a vacancy on the retirement commission, we spent a little time in our office wondering who we might make a recommendation to bring on board as a retirement commission member.

And I got to know Brian through the pandemic

in terms of trying to keep the state running. And knowing nothing about judicial, Brian was the expert and was very thoughtful and diligent in his decision making and his ability to share information and willingness to reach across the aisle with labor to ensure that the people who worked in judicial and the people they served were all safe and well taken care of. And that extended on through our SEBAC '22 negotiations where we again continued to work on that relationship.

So we made the recommendation then. It was granted by the governor's office to nominate Brian to the retirement commission, and I know he will continue to serve the State of Connecticut in the way he's been serving the judicial branch for years.

So, Brian, welcome. We're really happy to have you.

MR. HILL: Thanks so much, Dave. I really appreciate the kind words and the collegiality and collaboration over the last couple of years. I really just want to thank the commission. I'm really excited to take on this responsibility, and should note that I know that I'm filling big shoes in Bob Coffey's role, long, longstanding role with the commission. Bob was not only a friend, but a colleague, and maybe more

1 importantly, a mentor over the years that I knew him. 2 I had the great fortune for five years, about 3 five years, of sitting in his former role as director 4 of HR with judicial, and he was one of the kindest people, not only in his - just his way, but also with 5 his time post-retirement. And anyways, you know, I 6 7 wanted to recognize that and thank the commission 8 members and the chair for this welcome this morning and Dave. Thank you. 9 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Thank you, Brian. You 10 11 should find - you should know that we found out about Brian yesterday, and he offered to get up to speed and 12 to come prepared to this meeting. MR. HERRINGTON: So this is John Herrington. As I circulated the report earlier this morning, you'll see that we continue to hold court with respect to the disability retirements. I think that we definitely hit a groove where most individuals that submit complete packages are able to have their initial hearing within 90 days, which has been the long-term goal, and it appears as though that will be the new normal going forward.

You will also see that we continue to have relative or historical lows in terms of the regular retirement activity. We've only had 75 retirements

last month. We continue to see this trend. It seems as though anyone that was looking to retire in a brief window retired for 2022, for that July 2022 date, and it's just a question now how long these trends will hold.

With respect to the focus of the division, we continue to focus on our efforts to improve the MERS program, so there are a number of reforms that we continue to work through, and we're developing our best approach to informing, advising, and counseling the relevant entities and populations. We continue to formulate that plan. We continue to work with CavMac to develop tools that will make it easier for individuals to assess the impact of those changes on their benefits going forward.

As we will discuss in executive session, we are also working on one of the points that the CMERS working group came up with where there would be the creation of a CMERS subcommittee. We'll go over that in more detail in executive session.
