18	your appeal options.
19	MS. TRINENE DAVIS: So I'm not gonna be receiving any
20	benefits?
21	MS. CIESLAK: I don't know the current status, but
22	you've been denied, so yeah, if you are receiving benefits,
23	they're gonna be stopped.
24	MS. TRINENE DAVIS: Okay.
25	MS. CIESLAK: Okay.

1 MS. TRINENE DAVIS: And this is --2 BOARD MEMBER: They will be stopped. 3 MS. TRINENE DAVIS: -- what my doctor's saying I can't work in a hazardous duty job. And my job was hazardous duty, 4 5 and y'all can't place me back in a hazardous duty job, and you denied me my benefits. 6 7 MS. CIESLAK: Ms. Davis, we don't want to discuss medical information on a public meeting. You should call the 8 9 Retirement Services Division in order to discuss what your options are, and then you will receive a written decision 10 11 indicating the reasons that you were denied. 12 MS.
