11	MR. HILL: Second, Hill.
12	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. All in favor, say aye or
13	raise your hand. It's unanimous, the ayes have it. Okay.

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17	MR. LUCIANO: I'd like to make a motion this is Sal
18	Luciano, I'd like to make a motion that we send Mr. Treusch back
19	to the Overpayment Committee because he has no information.
20	MR. HILL: Second, Hill.
21	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Any discussion?
22	MR. CAREY: Yes, Mr. Chairman. This is Mike Carey. I
23	just want to make sure that it's clear that the Division is
24	going to continue with the payment plan as it is currently
25	implemented while this remand occurs.

1 MR. LUCIANO: Yep. Made no motion to change anything regarding that issue. 2 3 MR. CAREY: Perfect. Thank you. 4 MR. ROSE: Hello, this is Mike Rose. Could I suggest 5 that we have either two motions -- one is to accept his request 6 for reconsideration and then secondly to send it to the body, 7 because I think that's what Cindy was talking about before, 8 where normally we have to approve that request for reconsideration. 9 10 MR. LUCIANO: I don't think that's right yet. 11 why the I made the motion to send it back to the Overpayment Committee. 12 13 MR. ROSE: Right, you may be right. Cindy, is that 14 right? We don't have -- this committee doesn't have to accept 15 the request for reconsideration yet? 16 MS. CIESLAK: So ordinarily this committee would decide whether reconsideration is warranted. I think this 17 18 motion is to have the Overpayment Subcommittee take the matter 19 up in total --20 MR. ROSE: In total. MS. CIESLAK: -- meaning they get to decide if 21 22 reconsideration is warranted, and if so, they can review it on 23 reconsideration.

MR. LUCIANO: It needs the correct subcommittee,

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that's all.

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1 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: So there's a motion to remand on 2 the table? 3 MR. CAREY: Yes, sir. 4 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: And it's been seconded. Any 5 further discussion? Hearing none, at all in favor say aye or raise your hand. Opposed, nay. It's unanimous, the ayes have 6 7 it. Okay. 8 MR. LUCIANO: Sal Luciano. I'd like to make a motion 9 that we recommend approval on the Redding matter for the full 10 board next week. 11 MR. HILL: Second, Hill. 12 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. Any further discussion? 13 Hearing none, all in favor say aye or raise your hand. 14 unanimous, the ayes have it. 15 MR. LUCIANO: And I don't think any other motion is 16 required. 17 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. MR. LUCIANO: And so if that's the case, the only 18 19 thing left on the table is a motion to adjourn and I so move, Sal Luciano. 20 21 MR. HILL: Second, Hill. 22 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Any discussion?
