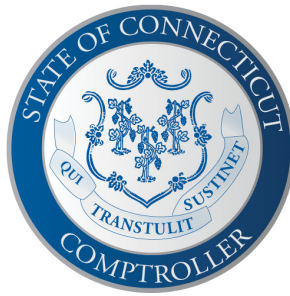

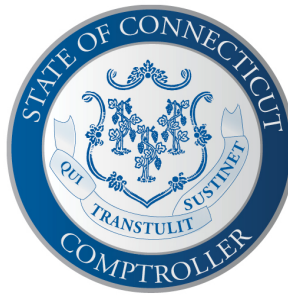

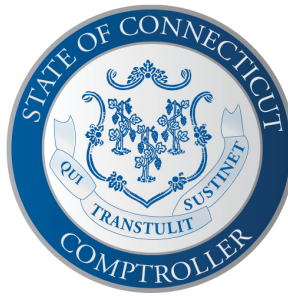
A. Pending Disability Applications for the Initial Review by the Medical Examining Board:
