1 (Proceedings commenced at 9:24 a.m.) MS. CIESLAK: Dr. Rosenberg, you can proceed when 2 3 you're ready. 4 CHAIRPERSON ROSENBERG: Thank you. Today is the July 26, 2024 meeting of the Medical Examining Board now in session. 5 6 Present is Dr. Poleak So, Dr. Frank Gerratana and myself, Dr. 7 Ralph Rosenberg. Present from the Office of the State 8 Comptroller's Office and Retirement Service Division are staff 9 members Robert Helfand, William Cassada, Helena Bartolomeo, 10 Nabil Waheed, and General Counsel to the Retirement Commission 11 and Medical Examining Board, Cindy Cieslak. I'd like to make a motion that we go into executive session. Is there a second? 12 13 DR. GERRATANA: Gerratana, second. 14 CHAIRPERSON ROSENBERG: All those in favor of going 15 into executive session, say aye. Rosenberg, aye. 16 DR. GERRATANA: Gerratana, aye. 17 DR. CIESLAK: This is Cindy Cieslak --21 CHAIRPERSON ROSENBERG: I'm sorry, I also request that 22 staff members of the Retirement Service Division, Robert 23 Helfand, William Cassada, Helena Bartolomeo, Nabil Waheed and the General Counsel, Cindy Cieslak continue with us into 24 25 executive session.

MS. CIESLAK: Thank you, Dr. Rosenberg. This is Cindy Cieslak. I'll just note for the record that as of right now, William Cassada is not here with us, but all the other individuals who were mentioned by Dr. Rosenberg are. We are going into executive session, which means all of the applicants here I'm going to place you back in the waiting room. doctors go into executive session because they will be discussing your confidential and private medical information that should not be, you know, given to the public. So we will be going into executive session, turning off the recording, and you will be in the waiting room. Everyone today is on reconsideration, so once the doctors have gone through all of the medical records from your applications they will invite you in to make a statement in support of your application. After they have spoken with everyone, we will re-enter public session at which time you will be able to hear the doctors vote on your application. If you are unable to wait, you will receive the written decision in the ordinary course. Keep in mind that the review of these records could take some time. Oftentimes we are in executive session for two to three hours. So just -- it's going to put you in the waiting room for quite some time. tight with us, okay? All right. I'm gonna start placing everyone in the waiting room.

HELFAND: Before -- before the doctors announce their decisions I just want to say to the applicants, ordinarily we get a report from the Social Security Administration so that lets us know if you're receiving any kind of Social Security benefits before the meeting. This -- for this meeting, the Social Security Administration was a little slow and we haven't yet received those reports. So if you are receiving Social Security benefits, and if you have not already let us know about that fact, please do so after the doctors announce their decisions if your application has been granted. Thanks.

CHAIRPERSON ROSENBERG: The Board has made its -MS. CIESLAK: I was just gonna say that you can
proceed Dr. Rosenberg.

CHAIRPERSON ROSENBERG: Thank you. The Board has made its determinations. I would like to remind members that only the final vote will be given today and not the reason for the vote. In some instances there may have been enough medical information -- there may not have been enough medical information to make a favorable determination. You may seek reconsideration of a denial. You will receive the Board's determination within 2 to 4 weeks, which will provide you with

1 that additional information. We will now vote on individual member entitlement to disability benefits. 2 This is Dr. Ralph Rosenberg and I make a motion to 3 4 deny non-service connected disability for Carmen Berroa. 5 there a second? 6 DR.
