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1 (Proceedings commenced at 9:03 a.m.) 2 CHAIRPERSON SO: The September 20, 2024 3 meeting of the Medical Examining Board is now in session. Doctor Sokpoleak So, chairperson. Present are 5 Dr. Nikolai Lieders, Dr. Eric Shore, Dr. Sokpoleak So. 6 Also present from the Office of State Comptroller, 7 Retirement Services Division are staff members from the 8 Retirement Services Division, Robert Helfand, Helena 9 Bartolomeo and Nabil Waheed. General counsel for the 10 retirement commission and Medical Examining Board, Cindy 11 Cieslak. I make a motion to enter executive session in 12 doctor a second. 13 DR. LIEDERS: Nikolai Lieders, second. 14 MS. CIESLAK: Dr. So, this is Cindy Cieslak. 15 Sometimes the doctors have me call the motions and ask 16 for the votes, and sometimes the doctors like to do it 17 on their own. After the doctors have reviewed all of the applications, we will reenter public session, which you will be invited back into so you can hear the decision at that time. This can take, you know, a couple of hours. We have a shorter agenda today, but sometimes it still takes some time to go through them. So if it ends up being a couple of hours, we're -- we're still here. Just hang with us. All right? Thank you.
