MR. HERRINGTON: Yes. Good morning, everyone. I've circulated the report. Things are standard from one month to the next. The retirements remain at historic lows if we look over decades, but they are creeping up a bit from past years.

The division as a whole, we continue to make progress on the technology side in establishing functionality to automatically enroll individuals in the proper tiers upon hire and to collect the correct contributions.

We're moving on to a next phase now. The more difficult piece is for people who are rehired and have prior state service and all of the logic that's required to place those individuals into the correct tiers, but that's a focus of the Division and we hope to make progress with that over the next couple of months.

The benefit of that is that we would collect the correct contribution amounts from day one, and that would eliminate a lot of activity where we need to either refund contributions that were excess contributions paid in error or to collect contributions that should be in the fund and were not in the fund for a period of time, so that's our next project, and we hope to make significant progress on that project by the end of July.
