8 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Yes. Good morning, everyone. This 9 is Cindy Cieslak. 1 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Thank you. We need two motions to 2 amend. Claude Poulin? 3 MR. POULIN: Yes, thank you Mr. Chairman --4 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Amend the agenda? 5 MR. POULIN: Mr. Chairman, I move to amend the agenda to add after Item 13, the following Item 14, to request the 6 7 Commission to accept the Connecticut Judges, Family Support Magistrates and Compensation Commissioners Retirement System, 8 9 GASB 67 report prepared as of June 30, 2024, and the following 10 Item 15, to request the Commission to accept the Connecticut 11 Judges, Family Support Magistrates and Compensation 12 Commissioners Retirement System -- this is a mouthful -- GASB 68 13 report prepared as of June 30, 2024. 14 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: What are the numbers now, Claude? 15 MR. POULIN: I'm sorry? 16 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: What numbers? 17 MR. POULIN: Sixty-eight, GASB 68. CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: No, no. Number 13? 18 19 MR. POULIN: This is Item 15. 20 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Item 15. 21 The second one is item 15. MR. POULIN: 22 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. What happened to 13? 23 MR. BAILEY: Thirteen is on the agenda Mr. Chairman. 24 MR. POULIN: I thought 13 was part of the agenda. 25 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: I got it. Okay.

1 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Mr. Chairman, this is Cindy Cieslak. I will note that the agenda that was posted does not 2 have an Item 13, however, I believe we're going -- we were also 3 4 adding a matter from the Investment Subcommittee. 5 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: We are. ATTORNEY CIESLAK: That was going to be Item 13. 6 7 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. The other motion to amend, 8 Mike Bailey. 9 MR. BAILEY: Yes, Mr. Chairman. Michael Bailey, I 10 move --11 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: I apologize for the interruption, this is Cindy Cieslak. Do we want to call or get a second for 12 13 Claude's motion and then --14 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Oh, I'm sorry. Yeah. I got 15 confused. 16 MR. BAILEY: Michael Bailey, second. 17 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Bailey, second. All in favor say aye or raise your hand. It's unanimous, the ayes have it. 18 19 Okay, now, Mike Bailey, please. 20 MR. BAILEY: Mr. Chairman, this is Michael Bailey. Ι move to amend the agenda to add Item number 18. Is that 21 22 correct, Cindy, or are we going back to 13? 23 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: 13. 24 MR. BAILEY: So 13 is on the agenda that I have; 25 Approval of the Probate Judges and Employment Retirement Fund

1 Personnel Expenses, that's no longer there? ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Well, so this is Cindy Cieslak. 2 We 3 might need to go through each of the items to figure out what is 4 on your agenda, 'cause I printed the one off that was posted online that has 12. Let me make sure I have the right date. 5 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Mine has 12. б 7 MR. BAILEY: I'm going to add Item number 18 and 8 request the Commission approval of the recommendations made by 9 the Investment Subcommittee at its March 4, 2025 meeting 10 regarding changes in bond fund allocations and fund expense 11 ratios. MR. KRAYESKI: Mr. Chairman, this is David Krayeski, I 12 13 second. 14 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. Any discussion? 15 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Mr. Chairman? 16 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Yeah? 17 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: This is Cindy Cieslak. Can we amend that to make it Item 16, then? 18 19 MR. BAILEY: 16. 20 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. 21 MR. POULIN: This is Claude. I think that the 22 confusion is that in my agenda there is an Item 13. 23 MR. BAILEY: Mine as well. 24 MR. POULIN: The original version did not contain Item 25 13.

1 MR. HERRINGTON: Correct, this is John Herrington. Ιt looks as though the item that was on the original agenda that 2 was posted -- that was circulated, had an Item 9, which was the 3 4 Preretirement Death Benefits. The one that was posted, that is the difference. 5 б MR. BAILEY: So Preretirement Death Benefits is no 7 longer on the agenda? 8 MR. HERRINGTON: Correct. 9 MR. BAILEY: Thank you. 10 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: All Right. 11 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Which means we can have the 12 Investment Subcommittee be Item 13, otherwise we're not going to 13 have an item 13. 14 MR. BAILEY: Got it. 15 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: What did you do? What did you just say, Cindy? 16 17 MR. BAILEY: Got it. CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Do we have a 13? 18 19 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: So, on the posted agenda, there is 20 no Item 13 and so I'm recommending that the current motion that has been moved and seconded be amended to make the Investment 21 22 Subcommittee matter Item 13. CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. All right, is there any 23 24 discussion? It's moved and seconded right? Hearing none, all 25 in favor say aye or raise your hand. It's unanimous, the ayes

have it. Okay, now, John Herrington.

2	MR. HERRINGTON: Yes, so, I think I need to add to the
3	confusion that we just resolved. So looking through the packet,
4	Item 9, the Preretirement Death Benefit, there are Preretirement
5	Death Benefits that need to be approved, so it appears that the
б	agenda that was circulated along with the items is correct. The
7	agenda that was posted with 12 items was incorrect.
8	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Oh, boy. And that's the agenda I'm
9	using.
10	ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Mr. Chairman.
11	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Yeah?
12	ATTORNEY CIESLAK: So we can amend the agenda as
13	follows; we can add as Item 13, well, maybe we just make 15 the
14	Preretirement Death Benefits. That's the easiest, I think.
15	MR. HERRINGTON: I think so.
16	ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Because you have to go with what's
17	been posted, so the easiest way is to make 15 the Request
18	Commission Approval of the Connecticut State Employees'
19	Retirement System, Preretirement Death Benefits.
20	MR. O'BRIEN: That would be 16.
21	ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Correct, 16.
22	MR. O'BRIEN: Yeah.
23	ATTORNEY CIESLAK: If someone wants to move that.
24	CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Yes, please. Is there a motion?
25	MR. BAILEY: Yes, Michael Bailey, Mr. Chairman. I

1 approve that amendment, and if somebody can repeat that for me, that would be great. 2 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: This is Cindy Cieslak. It should 3 4 be Request Commission Approval of the Connecticut State 5 Employees' Retirement System Preretirement Death Benefits, б February 2025. 7 MR. BAILEY: Is Item 15? 8 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Is Item 15. 9 MR. O'BRIEN: 16. ATTORNEY CIESLAK: 16, and Mr. Bailey has made that 10 11 motion. MR. O'BRIEN: Mike O'Brien, second. 12 13 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: All in the favor, say aye or raise 14 your hand. The ayes have it. Okay. This is going to be a very 15 interesting meeting. 16 Okay. Shall we proceed with John Herrington? 17 MR. HERRINGTON: Yes. Good morning, everyone. Again, I think this has been a consistent trend for a while. We 18 19 continue to have a historically low level of retirement activity 20 for SERS, but the numbers are ticking up slightly over last year. A great deal of our focus in the Division this month and 21 22 throughout the next couple of months would be towards the MERS 23 changes, like the July of 2022 changes there. We anticipate 24 that there's going to be a surge of activity for people retiring 25 from MERS, so that's kind of a focus of the Division going

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1	forward, and I think based on this meeting, next month's
2	priority is going to be to improve the quality control checks of
3	the agenda, drafting and posting.
