3 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay, we'll call the meeting  
4 to order. This is the monthly meeting of the  
5 Connecticut State Employees' Retirement Commission  
6 being held remotely using Zoom technology. Do you  
7 have the attendance, Cindy?

8 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Yes. Good morning,  
9 everyone. This is Cindy Cieslak. Present this  
10 morning we have Chairman Peter Adomeit, Trustee  
11 Michael Bailey; Tax Counsel from Robinson and Cole  
12 Bruce Barth; Trustee Michael Carey, Trustee Carl  
13 Chisem; General Counsel from Rose Kallor, Cindy

3 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay, Claude, we need a  
4 motion to amend the agenda, please.

5 MR. POULIN: Yes, Mr. Chairman, this is Claude  
6 Poulin. I move to amend the agenda to add after  
7 Item 14 the following Item 15; to request the  
8 Commission to accept the Connecticut Judges, Family  
9 Support Magistrates and Compensation Commissioners  
10 Retirement System Actuarial Evaluation Report  
11 prepared as of June 30th, 2025.

12 MR. LUCIANO: Sal Luciano, second.

13 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Any discussion? Hearing  
14 none, all in favor say aye or raise your hand.  
15 Opposed nay or raise your hand. It's unanimous.  
16 The ayes have it. Thank you very much.

17 There is going to be a very short Chairman's  
18 Report. Tim Ryor has resigned and has taken a new  
19 job with CavMac as of December 11th.

20 Okay, Division Director's Report.

21 MR. HERRINGTON: Yes, everyone, I've forwarded  
22 the report. Again, we have had relatively low  
23 retirement activity in SERS. Again, the numbers  
24 have been much lower in the past couple of years  
25 than they have been historically. I would say a

1 great deal of our emphasis over the past couple of  
2 months, and particularly this month, have been  
3 directed towards the MERS 2.0 implementations.

4 A lot of the things are relatively steady state  
5 for SERS. One thing that we'd like to make you all  
6 aware of is that, in connection with SERS, however,  
7 there was a disability retiree, and there was a case  
8 where someone did not respond to the annual survey  
9 and we stopped the checks for those people pursuant  
10 to the agreement, and through researching that we  
11 found that although the member had passed away,  
12 there were checks that continued to be paid to an  
13 account. And when we attempted to recoup those  
14 monies, there was no money in the account. That led  
15 to a coordination between this office and the Office  
16 of the State's Attorney, and there ultimately was an  
17 arrest last month of an individual who was  
18 collecting benefits on behalf of a deceased member.  
19 So, that does raise issues for us.

20 We continue to try to maximize our abilities to  
21 look into those types of cases, but this was clear  
22 evidence of fraud that we were able to uncover,  
23 stop, and to bring someone to justice.

24 MR. LUCIANO: Good work.

25 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Thank you. Thank you, John.

1 Any -- Any addition, John Herrington?

2 MR. HERRINGTON: Nope. I would say unless  
3 Trustees have questions.

4 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. Hearing none. Let's  
5 go on to New Matters.

6 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Mr. Chairman, this is Cindy  
7 Cieslak. I apologize for the interruption. If the  
8 individual at 9571 is a Trustee, can you identify  
9 yourself?

10 MS. BUFFKIN: It's Karen Buffkin, and I have to  
11 leave at 10 o'clock because I have a Board of  
12 Regents meeting today. But thank you.

13 ATTORNEY CIESLAK: Thank you. Thank you,  
14 Karen.

15 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: Okay. On to New Matters.

16 MR. BAILEY: Mr. Chairman, this is Michael  
17 Bailey. With your approval, I'd like to move to  
18 Item 15 on the agenda, seeing Larry Langer here and  
19 not requiring him to sit through the entire meeting.

20 MR. LUCIANO: Sal Luciano, second.

21 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: All in favor say aye.  
22 Opposed nay. It's unanimous, the ayes have it.

23 MR. BAILEY: Item 15 is to move to request  
24 Commission acceptance of the Connecticut Judges,  
25 Family Support Magistrates and Compensation

1 Commissioners Retirement System Actuarial Evaluation  
2 Report prepared as of June 30th, 2025.

3 MR. BAILEY: Sal Luciano, second.

4 CHAIRMAN ADOMEIT: All in favor say aye or  
5 raise your hand. Opposed nay or raise your hand.  
6 It's unanimous. The ayes have it.

7 MR. BAILEY: Thank you, Larry.

8 MR. LANGER: Thank you all. Have really good  
9 days. I don't think I'm needed anymore.

10 MR. BAILEY: No.

11 MR. LANGER: I saw one head shaking back and  
12 forth. You all have a great holiday season.
