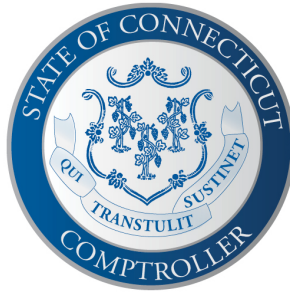

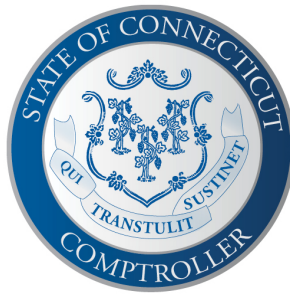

 - 18 Reconsideration cases to be scheduled in 2026 and have not provided updated medical documentation.
 - 53 Applications are scheduled for upcoming MEB meetings.

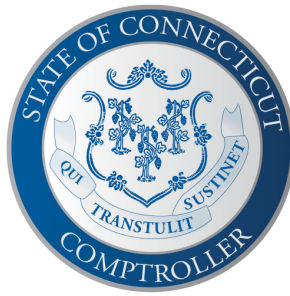
