COMPTROLLER SEAN SCANLON APPLAUDS PASSAGE OF BILL STRENGTHENING MYCTSAVINGS

(HARTFORD, CT) – Comptroller Sean Scanlon today released the following statement upon the Connecticut General Assembly's passage of <u>Senate Bill 1221</u>: An Act Making Changes to the Connecticut Retirement Security Program:

They've taught me a lot about how we can continue to strengthen this program and how much it means to business owners to provide their employees with the opportunity to save for retirement.
