24 MICHAEL O'BRIEN: Mike O'Brien, second.

25 PETER ADOMEIT: All in favor, say aye or raise

1 your hand. It's unanimous. The ayes have it.

2 New Business. Can we go into executive
3 session, please.

4 BRIAN HILL: This is Brian Hill. I make a
5 motion that we suspend the regular session to go into
6 executive session and invite Benjamin Sedrowski and
7 Robert Helfand because they may have information that's
8 relevant to our discussion, and Robin Kallor as well.

9 Pizighelli matter, I make a motion to recommend the full
10 Commission denial of Mr. Pizighelli's request.

11 MICHAEL O'BRIEN: Mike O'Brien, second.

12 PETER ADOMEIT: Any discussion? Hearing none,
13 all in favor say aye or raise your hand. Opposed nay or
14 raise your hand. It's unanimous. The ayes have it.

16 BRIAN HILL: This is Brian Hill. I make a
17 motion that we adjourn.

18 MICHAEL O'BRIEN: Mike O'Brien, second.
